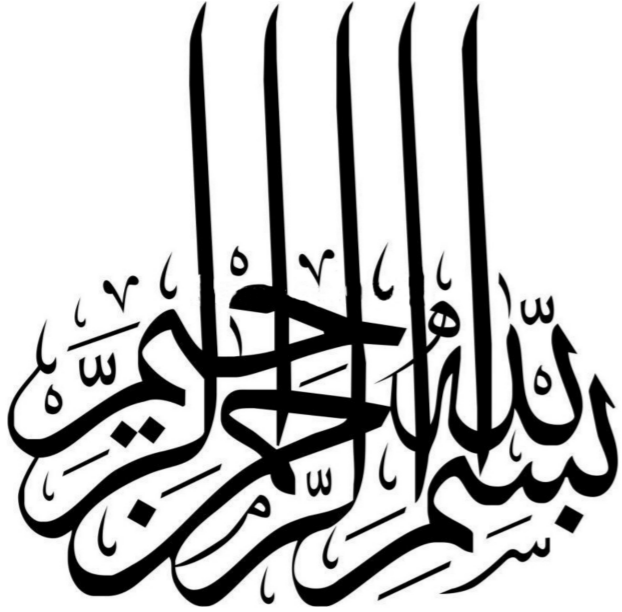

## THE COLLEGE

Govt. Girls College, D.G.Khan was started as an inter College in July 1966 in the building of Hindu School in D.G.Khan Mrs. Sakina Mehmood was First Principal. The present building had been founded in October 1971. This building was constructed according to the necessity of Inter Classes.

The College is located in the center of city. The building is spread over 13 Acres of land. The graduation classes started in December 1973. BS 4 years Program was introduced in 2010 in 8 disciplines and the college got the status of Post Graduation. The college through different phases has made great progress. 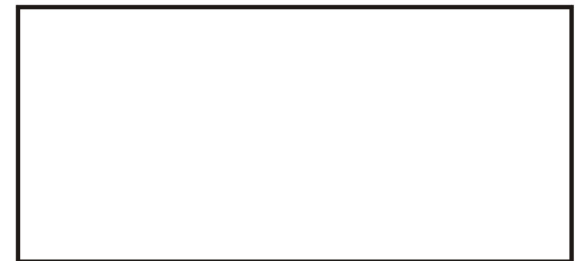
The College also has a video conference room which provides facilities like video calling, On Line Lecturer internet, virtual classroom etc. Seminars and conferences are held here.

### Day Care Centre for Staff and Students kids.

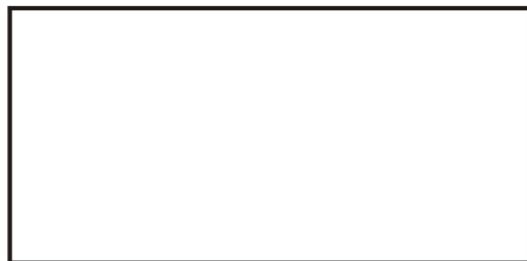
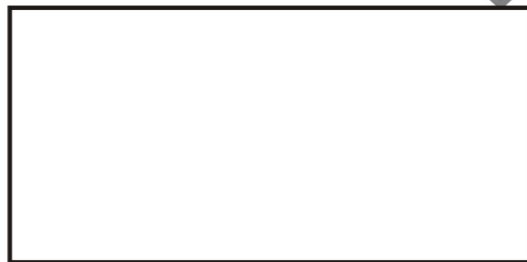

### Reserved Seats:

2% arts seat are reserved for best performance in sports to get admission on these seats, candidate are required to attach attested certificate along with the admission form.

### Seats for Ruler area:

15% seats are for these girls who have passed matric examination from High School of rural area/town committee.

### Seat for Special Persons:

Disabled candidates should attach certificate of Physical disability from the M.S of respective Hospital.

### Admission Criteria:

Admission to first year would take place according to the recommended date advertised in news papers by the Board.

1. Students would get admission according to their ability and present seat in the college.
2. For admission in 1st year (Arts) 45% marks in Matric are necessary.
3. For admission in 1st year (Science) and ICS 60% Marks with Science subject are must.
4. For admission in 1st year (Math) 45% marks in Maths are required.
5. These who have studied wiring and computer in Matric can't get admission in Biology
